For more than three decades, the name and voice of Tim Hughes has been a part of Utah broadcasting and the Salt Lake Community. He has been in the country music market and the talk show market. He has his own company "Voice by Hughes" and been featured on Home Show commercials, local TV station promotions and instructional videos. He has traveled the US as a ring announcer for mixed marital

arts events carried live on several stations and seen in over 130 countries.

In 2002, he became "The Voice of the Games" for NBC for the Salt Lake Olympic Games which led to additional Olympic opportunities in Athens, Greece, Torino, Italy and Beijing, China for KSL. DAN ENGLAND IS THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD and primary shareholder of C. R. England Inc., a Salt Lake City-based transportation provider. C.R. England is a privately held family company, today operated by third and fourth generation members of the England family, grandchildren and great-grandchildren of founder Chester England.

Established in 1920 in Plain City, Utah, C.R. England has grown from a simple one-man Utah-based trucking company to more than 7,200 drivers and employees with 3,900 trucks and 6,630 trailers. C.R. England is an industry leader in Dedicated, Over-The-Road, cross-border Mexico, and Intermodal services. C.R. England has also been regularly recognized for management excellence, including the 2020 Glassdoor Top Places to Work, the Achievers 50 Most Engaged Workplaces™ Award as well as a 2021 US Best Managed Company by Deloitte Private and Wall Street Journal.

C.R. England subsidiary England Logistics

offers a vast portfolio of non-asset based transportation solutions including full truck-load services, intermodal, dry and temp controlled LTL, parcel, and complete supply chain management. The company has often been honored in the industry, including recent recognition as one of the 50 Best Companies to Sell For by Selling Power magazine and being ranked in the Training Top 100 by Training magazine. Headquartered in Salt Lake City, UT, the company also has offices nationwide.

Overall, the C.R. England umbrella comprises multiple different business units and \$1.6 billion in annual revenues. Key customers include companies such as Hershey, Nestle, ConAgra, Walmart, Kraft, and Target. C.R. England is one of the top private employers in the State of Utah.

Mr. England earned a bachelor's degree in political science (1971) and a juris doctorate (1974) both from the University of Utah. In 1974 he entered private law practice where he specialized in insurance litigation and

transportation. In 1977 he joined the family business and became in-house legal counsel. In 1982, Mr. England was promoted to General Manager, a position he held until 1988 when he became CEO. He was elected Chairman of the Board in 2005.

His community service portfolio includes membership on the Select Health Board of Trustees and the board of Intermountain Donor Services. He currently serves on the National Advisory Boards of the University of Utah and the David Eccles School of Business. He has been honored as a Distinguished Alumnus by the College of Social and Behavioral Sciences of the University of Utah. In 2008, Mr. England was honored by the American Diabetes Association Father's Day Council as Father of the Year in the State of Utah. He is a member of the Utah State Bar Association and a past

member of the Young Presidents Association.

Mr. England is also a past Chairman of the American Trucking Associations, the largest national trade association and advocacy organization for the U.S. trucking industry. He served as Chairman of the ATA from October 2011 until October 2012.

During his tenure at C.R. England he developed relationships with various community programs, the most prominent company outreach today focuses on funding meals for children through partnerships with 22 food banks nationwide, including the Utah Food Bank. Since 2018, C.R. England and England Logistics have funded more than 6.5 million meals.

Dan is married to the former Jan Gibson, and they have four sons and thirteen grandchildren.
